# **Mid Anglia Centre Rules**

- 1. The speed limit is 5 mph and must not be exceeded at any time. This means walking pace. **Fully Licensed Drivers only**.
- 2. A 'pup' tent will be allowed within the area, normally occupied, by an awning or on the offside of the caravan, behind the towing vehicle within the length of the caravan.
- 3. All animals are to be kept under control and **must not** be allowed to run loose on the field. Recommended length of lead when tethered is a maximum of three meters (10 feet) and the animals must be exercised away from the pitching areas. Please keep animals away from water supply points on the Events Field.
- 4. Own sanitation must be provided.
- 5. Members arriving after 10.00pm are to site themselves in the 'late arrivals' section and be re-sited by the Events Marshals the following morning.
- 6. Members not attending the Event for which they have booked, will be charged any costs incurred by the Centre, unless written cancellation is received at least seven days prior to the commencement of the Event. Re-registration with the Centre will be denied to any member failing to honour his obligation in this respect. THE COMMITTEE'S DECISION IS FINAL.
- 7. Barbecues may only be used with the permission of the event marshals.
- 8. Ball games, including 'Swing Ball' must not be played, nor cycles ridden in the vicinity of the caravans.
- 9. **YELLOW FLAG**. In wet weather, a yellow flag flying means NO movement of vehicles, on or off the event field, except in an emergency.
- 10. Members should carry Caravan Club membership cards to ALL Centre events.
- 11. You will normally be asked to take your dry waste home.
- 12. A donation of £1 is required from anyone towed off an Event field, to cover the cost of the tow.
- 13. Always obey the Caravan Code and the Event Marshals.
- 14. Members are asked not to smoke at socials as requested by the venue or by the Events Marshals.
- 15. Children under eight must be under the direct supervision of their own parents or guardians at all Centre events.
- 16. The minimum age for children to join the Junior Committee is 8 years old.
- 17. It is suggested that generators are not operated after 6.00pm and before 9.00am.

PLEASE NOTE: Mid–Anglia Event Signs are 'day-glow' yellow in colour, with the letters 'MA' and an arrow showing direction.

#### Alcohol - Know Your Limits - Some interesting facts......

One unit is 10 ml of pure alcohol - the amount of alcohol the average adult can process within an hour. This means that if the average adult drinks a drink with one unit of alcohol in it, within an hour there should in theory be no alcohol left in their bloodstream, but that length of time could differ depending on a person's body size.

Some ales have an alcohol content of 3.5%, but stronger continental lagers can be 5% ABV, or even 6%, this means that just one pint of strong lager can equate to more than three <u>units of alcohol.</u>

Most wines are between 12 and 14%, and you may opt for a large glass, but a large measure is 250ml - which is one third of a bottle. This can be nearly three units of alcohol or more in just one glass. So if you have just two or three drinks, you could easily consume a whole bottle of wine - and almost three times the daily unit guidelines – without even realizing it.




